## **Beverly Hills woman who flew in private jet with 13 suitcases of marijuana indicted**

A Beverly Hills woman accused of traveling from Van Nuys to Ohio carrying more than 500 pounds of marijuana was indicted Thursday on conspiracy and drug charges.

Lisette Lee faces up to 40 years in federal prison and fines of \$2 million if convicted of conspiracy and possession of drugs with the intent to distribute, according to the U.S. Attorney's Office in Columbus, Ohio.

Lee, 28, was arrested Monday after federal authorities said she and three companions arrived in a private jet with 23 bales of marijuana weighing 506 pounds crammed into 13 suitcases.

Lee's companions, whom she identified as two personal assistants and a bodyguard, have not been charged.

According to the Drug Enforcement Administration, Lee told agents that her family was "associated" with several multimillion-dollar businesses and had a charter jet company on retainer.

Although CBS News initially reported that she may be an heir to the Samsung Electronics fortune, the company issued a statement late Wednesday denying any connection.

Lee's attorneys in Columbus could not be reached for comment Thursday.

A bond hearing is scheduled Friday in federal court in Columbus.
